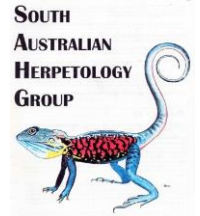

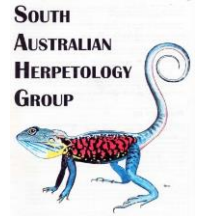

NEW MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION JULY 2021 – JUNE 2022

The South Australian Herpetology Group (SAHG) offers a variety of activities related to the research and keeping of reptiles and amphibians, with the aim of providing both enjoyment and conservation. Our group welcomes individuals and families to join, and prior reptile or frog expertise isn't required. We hope you find the SAHG informative and fun, and we welcome any new ideas and input at our meetings and on field trips.

As a member, you are welcome to attend our field trips and general meetings. Our general meetings are held over the cooler months of the year and in 2021 will be held on the third **Thursday of the month** at a venue in Adelaide CBD (further details will be made available on the SA Herpetology Group website and reminders about upcoming talks are posted on the Facebook group). We begin at **7:30pm** with an informal meeting and a guest speaker. Meetings usually last about 1.5 hours and provide an opportunity to learn about the biology of the fascinating reptiles in our state and beyond, find out about upcoming field trips, share ideas and ask for husbandry hints. A Christmas event is held late in the year, with details emailed out to members.

A range of field trips are organised through the warmer months, from day trips around Adelaide to overnight and long weekend trips further afield. Field trips are a great way to become familiar with identifying reptile and frog species, handling, research and surveying techniques. They are fun and enjoyable way of mixing with other members who share similar interests. As a member, you are covered by our insurance on field trips and can undertake wildlife-related activities in accordance with our research permits.

Membership renewal is due in July each year, and New Year (six-month) membership is offered if joining after the 31st of December. Renewal notices are usually issued by email. Please keep us up-to-date of any changes in address or other contact details, and don't hesitate to contact members of the committee if you have any SAHG membership issues.
